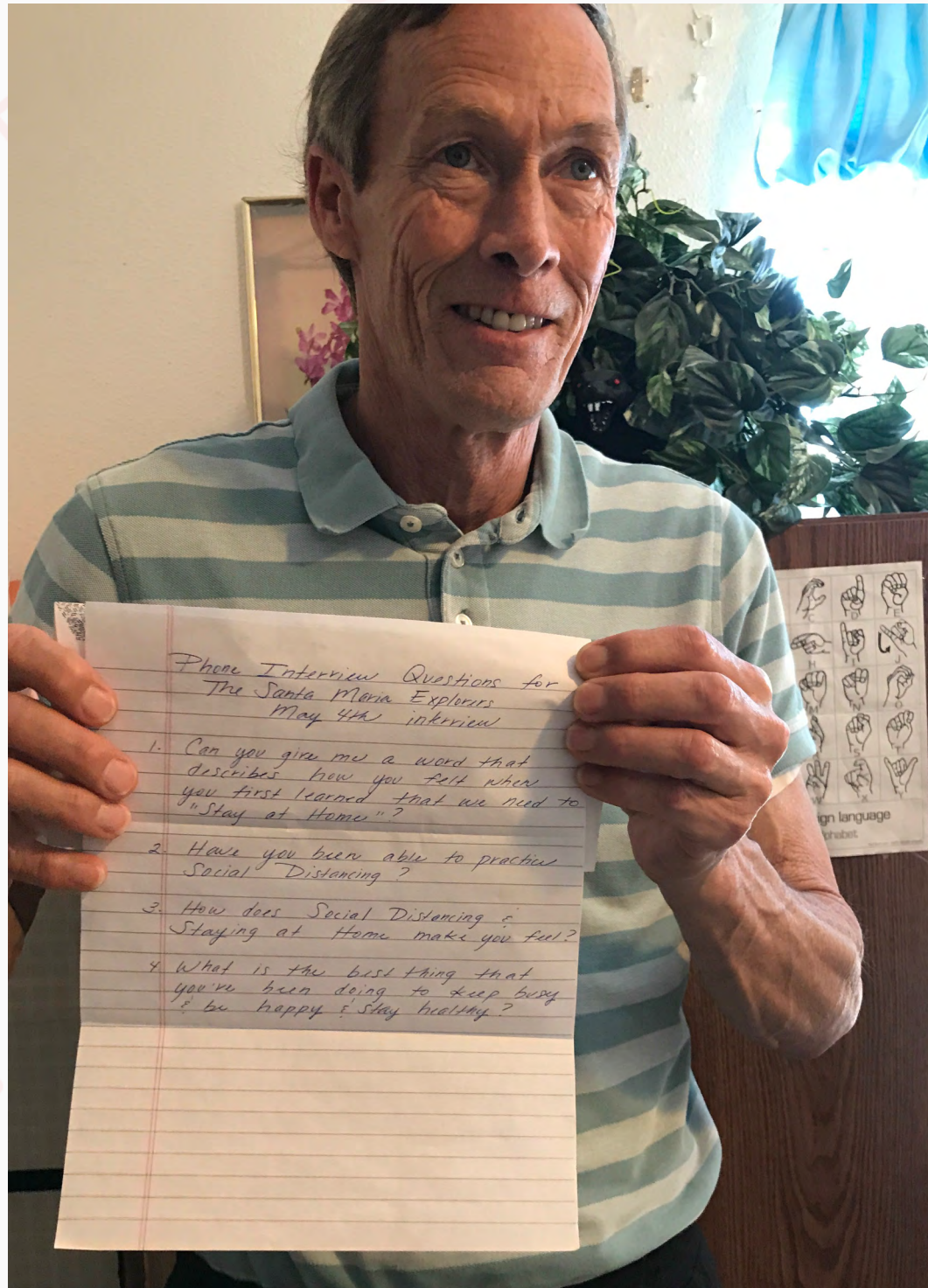

"Yes."



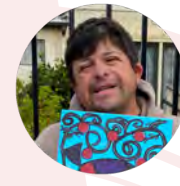
